The City reserves the right to negotiate with any and all firms submitting proposals, in accordance with 40 CFR 31.36.

This contract is contingent upon release of funds from the TWDB. Any contract awarded under this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is expected to be funded in part by a loan from the TWDB. Neither the State of Texas nor any of it departments, agencies, or employees are or will be a party to this RFQ, or any resulting contract.

This contract is subject to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) "fair share policy", which includes EPA-approved "fair share goals" for Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) firms in the Construction, Supplies, Equipment and Services procurement categories. EPA's policy requires that applicants and prime contractors made a good faith effort to award a fair share of contracts, subcontracts, and procurements to Small, Minority, and Women owned Business Enterprise's (SMWBE). Although EPA's policy does not mandate that the fair share goals be achieved, it does require applicants and prime contractors to demonstrate use of the six affirmative steps.
